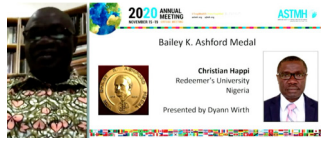

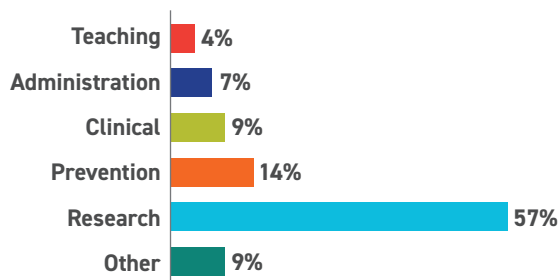

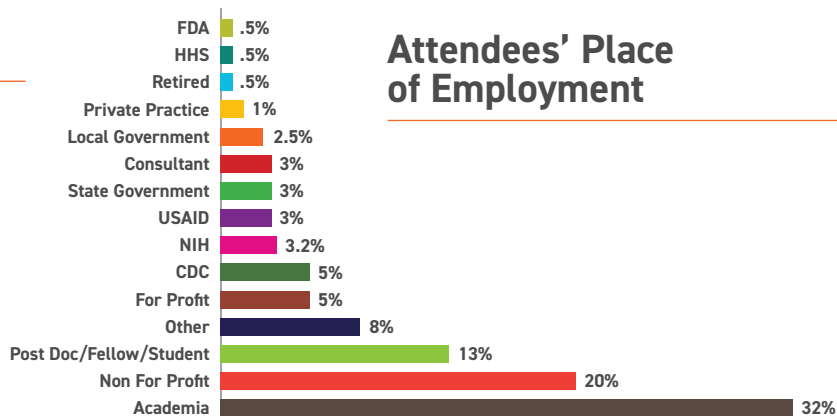

About the ASTMH Annual Meeting: The ASTMH Annual Meeting draws tropical medicine and global health professionals representing academia, foundations, government, not for profit organizations, non-governmental organizations, the private sector, military and private practice. The meeting is designed for researchers, professors, government and public health officials, military personnel, travel clinic physicians, practicing physicians in tropical medicine, students and all healthcare providers working in the fields of tropical medicine, hygiene and global health.

Will ASTMH hold an in-person meeting this year, and what does this mean to Exhibitors?

Yes. ASTMH will offer attendees the option to attend in person or virtually. For a single rate, all exhibitors will receive an in-person booth and a virtual booth on our virtual platform.

Can I use the virtual booth component only and not the in-person virtual component?

No, we cannot offer only one component of the package.

How do I collect my leads/prospects?

Lead retrieval units will be provided to all in-person exhibitors. Leads on the virtual platform will be collected by running an exhibitor report on the platform.

Besides an in-person and virtual booth, what other benefits are included in the booth package?

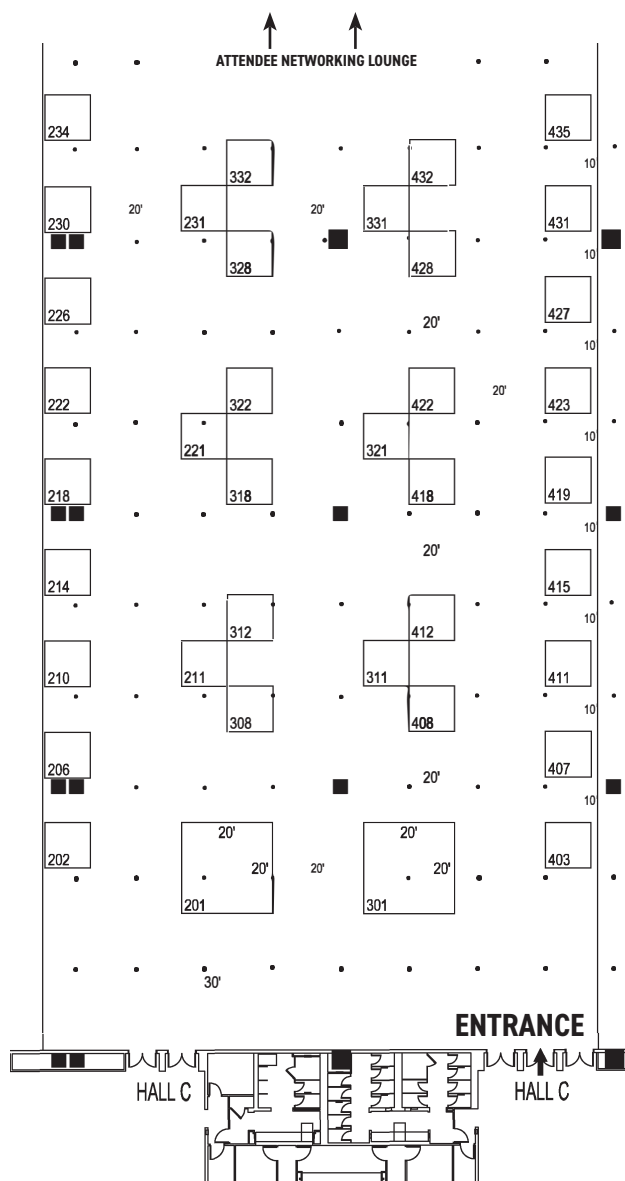
Will a GES staff member be available in the exhibit hall?

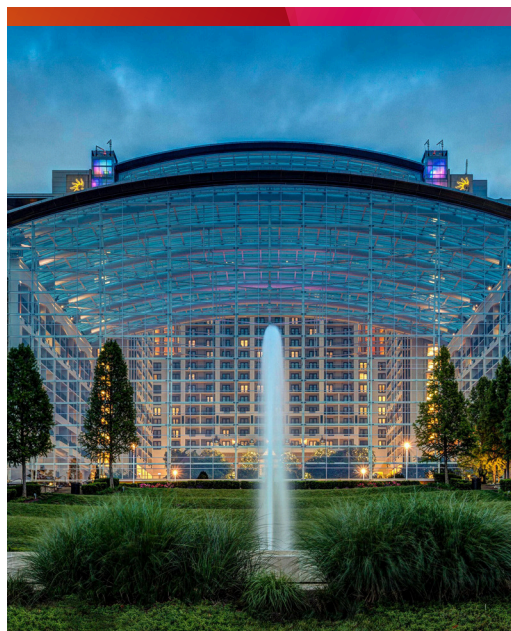
