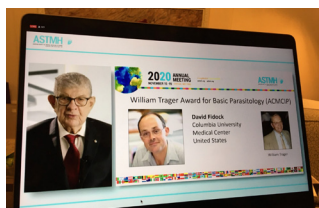

**APPLICATION DEADLINE: APRIL 21, 2021**

ASTMH Presidents' Challenge, BMGF Travel Awards support the travel of selected students, young investigators and scientists actively working in the tropical medicine field to attend and participate in the Annual Meeting. Awardees are selected through a competitive process. Those selected participate in the meeting through oral or poster presentations. Selections are based on abstract quality, research results and career development potential. ASTMH membership is not required. Residents of **Low and Low-Middle Income Countries (LMIC)** are particularly encouraged to apply.

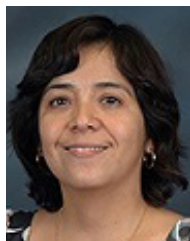

**AWARD:** Up to **\$500 US** cash award and complimentary registration.

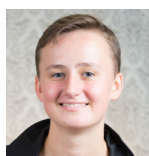

(Country of primary institution must be non-U.S.)

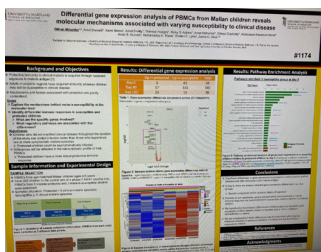

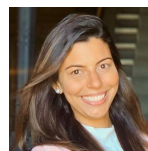
