

ePoster Hall Gallery Presenter Instructions

All posters will be available for viewing throughout the entire Annual Meeting.

How do I access my poster?

- Once you log onto the Livestream Portal, click the e-Posters button to access the ePoster Hall Gallery.
- Click the Login button in the upper right corner.
- **You will NOT access the ePoster Hall Gallery using the Poster Submission Portal where you uploaded your abstract.** You will access your poster by clicking the e-Posters button in the Livestream Portal.



How do I find my poster in the ePoster Hall Gallery?

- When you reach the ePoster Hall Gallery, click **Poster Hall Gallery View** in the blue bar at the top of the page.
- Use your Abstract Presentation Number to locate your poster. The posters appear in numerical order by Presentation Number. Use the SEARCH field if needed.

Late-Breaker Posters and SEARCH field: When using the SEARCH field in the Poster Hall, place quotes around the presentation number. For example, insert **"LB-8000"** when using the SEARCH field to search for Late-Breaker presentation number LB-8000.

- Your Abstract Presentation Number appeared in the letters you were sent in August and September.
- If you do not know your Abstract Presentation Number and you cannot find your poster, the Program Book will be available beginning Wednesday, October 18. Beginning Wednesday, October 18, [click here to find your Abstract Presentation Number](#) in the Program Book (for abstracts submitted in March) or Late-Breaker Abstract Presentation Schedule (for abstracts submitted in July).

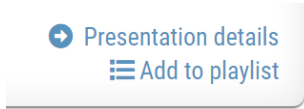
Additional Tips

- In the blue bar at the top of the ePoster Hall Gallery, click Poster Number Directory to view a directory of each poster session by topic.
- Use the scroll wheel of your computer mouse to "zoom in" for a closer look.
- Click the magnifying glass in the upper right corner of the poster to view the poster in full screen.

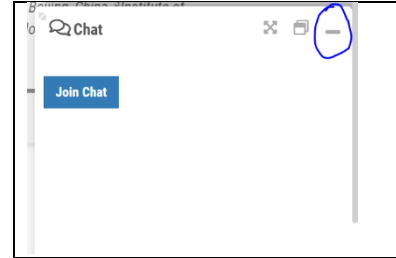

How do I chat with visitors to my poster?

- When you have located your poster, click “Presentation Details” at the bottom of the poster thumbnail view.



- When viewing a poster in full screen, a Chat Box will open. Click “Join Chat.”
- You can minimize the Chat Box by clicking the horizontal “Minimize Bar” in the upper right corner.



- During your poster presentation, we suggest that you begin the chat by typing a brief message to introduce yourself as the poster presenter. For example, begin the chat with a message such as:
“Hello, my name is Susan Smith. Thank you for visiting my poster. Can I answer any questions for you?”
- Please note that all posts to the Chat Box will be visible by all meeting attendees.

Poster Presentation and Viewing Schedule

- All posters will be available for viewing throughout the entire Annual Meeting.
- The posters in the ePoster Hall Gallery will primarily be viewed on an On-Demand basis. The ePoster Hall Gallery features a Chat function (typed messages into a Chat Box) whereby presenters and attendees can communicate when their schedules permit. As such, most Chats will take place on an asynchronous basis rather than in real time.
- Poster Sessions have been organized as follows; the in-person Poster Sessions at the Hyatt Regency Chicago will follow this schedule.
