(If you already have the meeting app on your mobile device, skip to the next step)

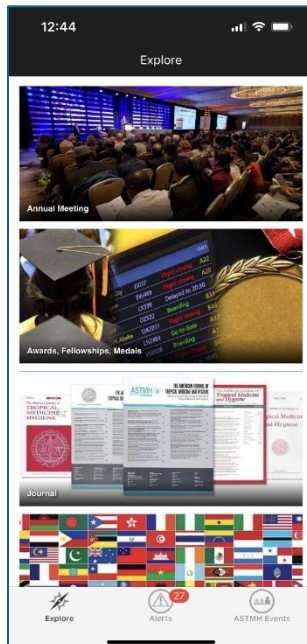


To Download the App on Your Mobile Device

1. Open your phone's camera
2. Point it at the QR code below
3. Tap the link that appears

- Click **ASTMH 2025 Annual Meeting** under Upcoming Events to download the meeting app.

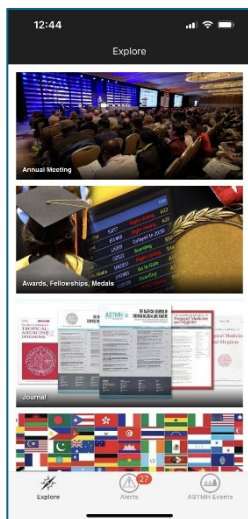
If You Already Installed the Meeting App on Your Mobile Device

If you already have the app on your mobile device, you'll see one of the two screens below, depending on which page you last viewed:



1. If you see this page, click the **gear icon** at the top to open the **Settings** page.

- Select **Exit to Past Meetings**.
- Tap **ASTMH Events** in the lower-right corner to return to the event list.
- Click **ASTMH 2025 Annual Meeting** to download.



2. If you see this page, Tap **ASTMH Events** in the lower-right corner

Once you have downloaded and opened the 2025 ASTMH meeting app...

Create your profile and start networking with other registered attendees

1. **Open the App**

Launch the ASTMH Annual Meeting app on your device.

2. **Tap the Menu Icon**

Look for the three horizontal lines (≡) in the upper corner.

3. **Select “My Profile”**

Tap on **My Profile** to access your personal profile settings.

4. **Tap “Edit” or the Pencil Icon**

This will open your profile for editing.


5. **Enter Your Information**

- Name
- Job title
- Organization
- Email
- Upload a photo (recommended!)

6. **Tap “Save”**

7. **Make Sure to Publish Your Profile**

After saving, tap **Publish** so other attendees can view your profile and connect with you.

 **Note:** You can update or hide your profile at any time under your profile settings. Publishing your profile helps maximize networking opportunities during the meeting.

You will **only be able to network with attendees who also publish their profiles.**

More to come ...

Meeting organizers are continuing to work on the scientific program. When that material becomes available in the app, we will let everyone know via email, social media, the ASTMH website and push notifications. In the meantime, here are some of the features to come:

Use the Meeting App to:

- Search the full Annual Meeting program, including all scientific sessions, poster sessions and presenters.
 - Search by speaker, abstract, topic or session type.
 - View and filter sessions designated as Educational Content.
 - Learn about sponsors and exhibitors.
 - Use content tags to find sessions on specific topics (use hashtag format, e.g., #malaria).
 - Network with peers and connect with fellow attendees.
 - Access interactive maps and important alerts.
 - Build and manage your personal schedule.

Sessions Designated for Educational Content

Educational sessions offer didactic instruction on specialized topics, public policy, and overviews of novel diseases and therapeutics. Look for sessions labeled as Educational Content in the Pocket Guide or use the Educational Content filter in the app.

Use Content Tags to Find What Matters

To help you navigate the program, content tags appear at the end of Symposia and Scientific Session descriptions. Search for sessions using these hashtags (e.g., #dengue, #globalhealth) right in the app's search bar.
