



Call for ASTMH Distinguished International Fellow

Application deadline: March 20, 2023

ASTMH Distinguished International Fellow formally recognizes up to eight individuals who have made eminent contributions to a particular aspect of tropical medicine/global health or hygiene. The nominee is expected to have made seminal contributions to tropical medicine/global health or hygiene over their career, as evidenced by publications, public health policy, and/or education work that have changed understanding of disease, changed health outcomes or developed capacity for tropical medicine/global health or hygiene work. Distinguished International Fellows typically acquire these accomplishments over several decades of work.

Nominations are limited to non-U.S. citizens. Dual citizenship is not accepted. The individuals recognized by the ASTMH Board as meeting this exceptional standard will be acknowledged at the Annual Meeting in October 2023. View the complete [list](#) of honorees.

Submission requirements (all documents should be uploaded as one single PDF file):

- Nomination letter (one page maximum)
 - Those nominating a candidate must be a current member of ASTMH. Nominees do not need to be a member of the Society. Self-Nominations will not be accepted.
- Letters of support, each no longer than two pages that clearly and succinctly outline the individual's contribution, impact and specifically related honors, achievements, standing in the field, etc. Up to two letters of support can be submitted. Support letters are not required but are highly recommended.
- Candidate's curriculum vitae
- Current, high resolution headshot photo of candidate
