

Call for Young Investigator Award Committee Members

Application deadline: May 8, 2023

ASTMH is seeking applications from Society members who are interested in serving on the Young Investigator Award (YIA) Committee (3-year term). For many, the best part of this committee is serving as a judge for the YIA competition at the Annual Meeting, encouraging young minds as they navigate their career.

Now in its 38th year, the YIA competition was established to recognize the work of outstanding young investigators and encourage developing scientists to pursue careers in various aspects of tropical disease research.

To date, 463 young investigators have been recognized from 22 countries. Perhaps the Society's most notable YIA is Dr. Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus, Director-General of the WHO, who received an award in 1999.

Who can apply?

- Society members* who welcome an opportunity to encourage up-and-coming scientists in their career paths.
- Strongly encouraged to apply:
 - The committee is seeking a higher representation of non-U.S. members, especially those from LMICs.
 - o Former YIA presenters.
 - Members with 10+ years experience mentoring junior scientists on their research and career paths.

- At least 10 years experience with global health research.
- Current member in good standing (dues paid) of the ASTMH.
