This session will help the audience **reflect** on and potentially **reframe** their relationship with organizational politics.

Organizational politics is a sometimes controversial topic and it can be particularly difficult for women leaders. This often leaves women leaders with a limited set of choices- embrace it as a necessary evil, engage half-heartedly or refuse to play the game. Research has found that politically savvy leaders have better career prospects. Leaders who stumble through political realities are missing opportunities, connections, and resources.

While the term political skill generally elicits negative perceptions, it isn't inherently a bad thing. Politics are a neutral and natural part of everyday life in organizations and a skilled leader understands that it is a necessary strategic choice.
